- 4) Sarah's class collected 234 cans for a food drive. They collected 189 more cans the next week. If they donated 315 cans to the food bank, how many cans do they have left?

- 5) A grocery store had 568 apples. They sold 296 apples on Saturday and received a shipment of 150 more apples on Sunday. How many apples does the store have now?
