- 3) The zoo welcomed 1,356 visitors on Saturday. On Sunday, they had 289 fewer visitors. If 178 people had two-day passes, how many different people visited the zoo over the weekend?

- 4) Ms. Lee's class collected 234 bottle caps for an art project. They used 156 bottle caps and then collected 83 more. How many bottle caps do they have now?

- 5) A farmer picked 467 apples from his orchard. He sold 289 at the market and then picked 125 more. How many apples does the farmer have now?
