- 4) Olivia read 78 pages of her book on Saturday and 94 pages on Sunday. If her book has 210 pages, how many pages does she have left to read?

- 5) The community garden grew 567 tomatoes. They donated 289 tomatoes to a food bank and then harvested 134 more. How many tomatoes do they have now?
